The Outer Harbour Marina consists of 143 berths serviced by power, water and onsite security.

Accommodating boats from 30ft to 70ft, Outer Harbour offers a protected mooring for your boat and all berths have a minimum depth of 10ft at low water.


Inner Harbour provides safe moorings with Broadwater access for up to 56 boats to a length of approximately 30ft. There is a minimum depth of 5ft at low water and 10ft clearance under the bridge which forms an impressive entrance to Middle Harbour.











Magnificent sailfish abound with wahoo, mackerel and tuna to entertain even the most experienced fisherman.
